We actively support many programs for local youth include providing books to underprivileged children, presenting the Rotary Youth Leadership Awards to local high school juniors and the Teen Leadership Camp for local junior high school students.

In addition, the Rotary Club of San Marino works in conjunction with international clubs such as the Rotary Club of Rosarito Beach, Mexico. Our club provided funding for the development of a youth soccer league in Rosarito Beach to promote activities to enrich the lives of kids in the area. We also provided funding to the Burns Ward Project in Ludhiana, India.

Our largest and most successful fundraiser is the annual San Marino Motor Classic which donates its proceeds to numerous local charities.

## VISITING A MEETING

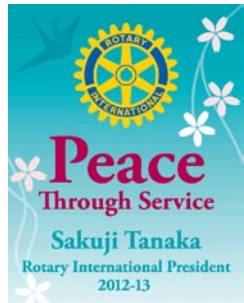

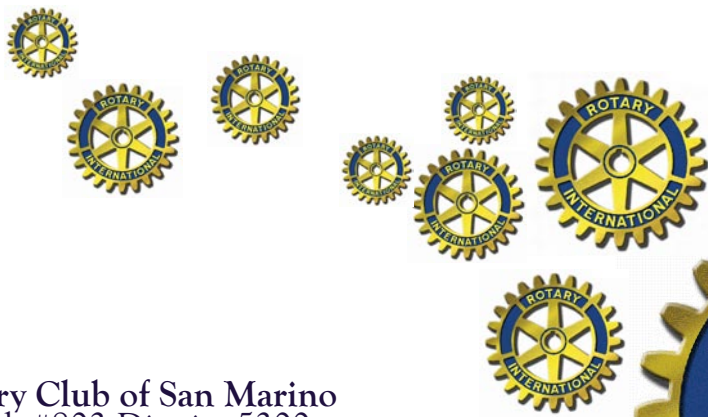
