PROJECTS

- 3. Hobby Committee: The popularity of this event last year was discussed, and there was some difference of opinion as to the benefits received. - 4. <u>Fartherest Away Visitor</u>: There was some discussion on how to honor these distant visitors, and Fellowship Committee was asked to check further.
- 5. <u>California Boys State</u>: It was decided to have Bill Lisenbard, our protege at the California Boys State School, as our guest at a Rotary luncheon as soon as possible.

The Special Activities Committee developed a special prize in mathematics at the High School. The scouts were sponsored by the club, and expenditure needed totaled approximately \$230.00.

Organization of Explorer Troop Unit \$100.00

Other projects were: purchase of new songbooks, gift for Rotary Club of Altadena, Halloween party for children of all service clubs, purchase of new receptable for collecting fines and Scout troop.
