Communication might be the very definition of art. How well does your art speak to the viewer? Composition is the art of arranging your elements to communicate your theme. Creativity is a child of imagination. Technique is the method or way the art is done to best communicate your theme.

Themes

6th -8th grade theme is "I'm Passionate About...."

9th -12th grade students choose your own theme.

Award Categories

6th-8th Grade Award Categories:

Category 1: **Painting & Drawing:** Oil or Acrylic painting, Watercolor, Black & White or Color Drawing and Animation Painting or Drawing.

Category 2: **2D Mixed Medium & 3D Art:** Sculpture, Ceramics, 3DFine Art or 2D & 3D Mixed Medium in any material.

9th-12th Grade Award Categories:

Category 1: **Painting:** Oil or Acrylic Painting, Watercolor or Animation Painting

Category 2: **Sketching:** Drawing in black and white or color.

Category 3: **2D Mixed Medium & Graphic Art:** Brochure, Poster, Editorial, CD cover, logo, Letter Head, Print Making, Collage, Stamp Art, Marker Pens or any medium material.

Category 4: **Photography:** B&W or Color. Traditional shot or Photoshop-Generated

Category 5: **3D Art:** Sculpture, Ceramics, 3DFine Art or Mixed Medium in any material

Category 6: **Digital Media /Video:** Website, Web ad, Short story film, Animation film. (Please submit film via YouTube web link. You must also include completed information from entry form emailed to graceyangdesign@hotmail.com.)

Awards

The top two winners in each category will receive cash awards.

All winners in each category will receive certificates.

All winners and an adult/guardian will be invited to attend the Award Ceremony

at the Rotary Club of San Marino on Thursday, April 12, 2018 from 12:15-1:30 pm. All winning artists with their entries will be taken by photographers and published in the San Marino Tribune and Rotary website at www.sanmarinorotary.org.

Rules:

All entries must include the **Art Contest Entry Form**. You will need to print the Art Contest Entry Form at www.sanmarinorotary.org. And attach on the back of art work (left corner).

All art pieces **must be mounted on foam core or illustration board** except oil and acrylic paintings on canvas.

All pieces are to be **unframed**.

Artist can submit **one piece per award category**. The same piece may not be submitted for multiple categories.

Deadline for Submissions: Thursday, March 15, 2018 at 9 pm to the Crowell Public Library.

All submissions will be submitted through their art teacher.

Winners will be contacted by email by their art teachers on April 3, 2018.

Art teachers and students may pick up student artwork on April 13-27 at Crowell Public Library.
